William Burding Jr. joined Orange Coast Title Company and its Family of Companies in 1998 and serves as its executive vice president and general counsel. He graduated cum laude with a bachelor's degree in Political Science from Whittier College and received his juris doctorate from Loyola Law School-Los Angeles.
